CITY OF CHESTER'S 34TH ANNUAL CHRISTMAS ON THE RIVER CELEBRATION

PARADE INFORMATION, RULES AND GUIDELINES 2022

The parade will be held on Saturday, December 3, 2022 at 5:30 PM. The parade will line-up in front of the Chester High School. Participants should turn onto Hoppe Drive from State Street to line-up and may begin doing so at 4 PM (not before). All entries must be in place by 5:15 PM. The parade will step off at 5:30 PM, move southwest on Swanwick Street. It will turn left on West Stacey Street and immediately right onto State Street. It will continue on State Street ending at Church Street, (Chester Car Wash) where parade participants will turn right Church Street and left onto Swanwick Street. Participants may use the KC Hall parking lot as a pick up point.

Failure to follow rules / regulations will be grounds for removal from this parade.

Staff will be onsite to direct and assist you the day of the event.

NO PARADE ENTRIES MAY HAVE A MEMBER DRESSED AS SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS.

1. All Parade entries shall maintain a distance of no closer than 20 feet to the entry in front of them.
2. All floats and participants are required to continue moving throughout the parade route. NO STOPPING will be allowed unless the parade is stopped as a unit. No entry shall be allowed to stop to allow photos, to "perform" or to drop off parade participants.
3. DO NOT stop your vehicle or group unless instructed to do so by a member of the Parade Committee or by the Chester Police/Fire Department personnel.
4. You must keep the same pace and distance as the entry in front of you. (Gaps in the parade could lead to vehicles pulling into the line of parade marchers)
5. All drivers of any motorized vehicle must be 18 years of age or older, must have a valid driver's license, and must have in their possession, the day of the parade, proof of insurance for the vehicle they are driving.
6. All vehicles must remain in the traffic lanes of the roadway.
7. Trailers are required to have functional tail lights. Trailers must have sides high enough that children (if riding) cannot fall over sides. Trailers must be securely attached to the towing vehicle.
8. Children under the age of 12 are not allowed to ride on floats unless accompanied by an adult.
9. At no time shall anyone be seated on the sides or tailgate of a pickup or have arms or legs hanging over the side.
10. All motorized vehicles (3-wheelers, 4-wheelers, golf carts, motorcycles, mopeds, lawn mowers, tractors, dune buggies, jeeps, miniature cars, etc.) must be operated by an adult, licensed driver, and MUST lighted!!
11. Walkers are required to have some form of Holiday lighting.
12. If distributing candy or trinkets: it must be thrown or tossed to the curb and away from the path of vehicles or walkers may pass from one hand to another.
13. Holiday music is permitted on parade entries and MUST be "child" appropriate.
14. Remember, this is a lighted Christmas parade, all entries must be adorned with lights.
